Our school is home to the Gators, and our school colors are green and white. We are a community school, and feed into Glenn Hills Middle and High Schools. Glenn Hills Elementary School is located on the highest hill in Augusta near the intersection of Bobby Jones Expressway and Deans Bridge Road. We are in the vicinity of Augusta Technical College.

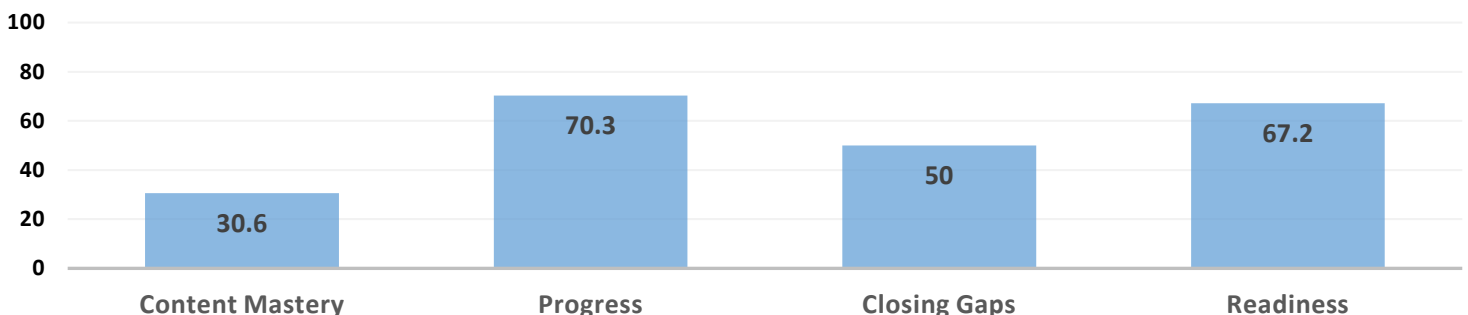
Our Points of Pride:

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers, and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures student achievement on indicators such as content mastery, student growth on progress, subgroup performance on closing gaps, and various areas including Lexile performance, attendance, and other academic based measurements. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Each individual component score is on a scale of 0-100.
