**Course Description:** The band program at Richmond Hill Middle serves as an enrichment for students beyond the classroom. Students will learn, develop, and apply the fundamentals and elements of music: melody, harmony, timbre, form, rhythm, texture, and expression. This curriculum is designed to establish a deeper appreciation for music, such that students will be able to create, perform, respond, and connect with music at a comprehensive level. By transferring prior knowledge of music, integrating with other subject disciplines, and exploring innovations, students will gain self-discipline, respect, and an enlightenment by the musical progression that transpires.

**Materials**

**Procedures**

1. Place all personal belongings in a designated area.
2. Assemble all instruments and equipment needed for instruction.
3. Sit in the assigned seat per your instrument (whole class or sectionals).
4. Disassemble all instruments and equipment.
5. Gather all personal belongings before exiting the band room.

- 40%Major (Playing Test and Quiz)  
60%Minor (Daily Participation)



### **Performance and Attire**

All band performances are **MANDATORY** only the band director have permission to excuse you; performance failure to perform will result in failing grade for band. Attire will be discussed in band app following itinerary for performance. Concert winter and spring attire will be black and white with dress shoes or heels and flats. Young men will wear white dress shirt, black slacks, and dress shoes. Young Ladies black dress and heels or flats.

### **Band Participation Expectation**

1. Classroom participation is required to receive grade in class.
2. After-school practice is mandatory only excused by band director. Daily attendance will be taken and added to your major grade if after school practice are missed. (Only selected 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade band student by Band Director)
3. Large Group Performance Evaluation and Concerts are Mandatory for all band students in Richmond Hill Middle School band program. Failure to participate will result in failing grade on Major grade for the year. (This performance is to gauge where the band stands musically as an ensemble. So, participation in performance is mandatory)
4. Student will have Playing Test on (Songs, Scales, etc.) for a major grade at the end of the week (Schedule will be sent out for playing test days since we are A and B schedule school).

\*\*\*\*Student who fail to follow the expectation will be removed from the band program and will take general music course\*\*\*\*\*

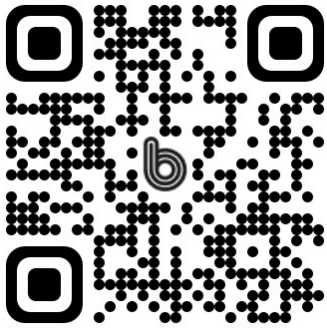
