Location: Lucy C. Laney Stadium, 1339 Laney Walker Blvd., Augusta, GA, 30901

Time: Gates open at 8:00a. Coaches Meeting at 9:00a. Meet starts promptly at 9:30a

Eligibility: This meet is open to any athlete in grades 2-5, in a Richmond County school.

Athletes in grades 2-5 may participate in no more than 3 events. If an athlete is entered into too many events, meet management reserves the right to reject the athlete from one or more events without notification. **Each school can only enter 4 participants per event, per gender, per grade.** Athletes under 5 years of age may participate ONLY in our Tiny Tykes 50M Dash.

Meet Entry Fee:

Entry fee is \$5 for each athlete for Track & Field events.

ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID by **May 12, 2025**. Entry will not be processed unless entry fee is paid by the deadline. School should make their checks payable to C.T. Walker. School Bookkeepers shall receive invoices from C.T. Walker.

Entry Process:

All schools will enter participants on the Google Doc completely with all information requested. Entry deadline date is **May 12, 2025 – 10am EST**

Packet Info will be emailed to all Coaches participating and they are responsible for disseminating to their athlete's parents/guardians.

PE Teacher/Coach Responsibilities:

If a PE Teacher or Coach is not available, a representative from participating schools MUST be present for the entirety of the meet.

All PE Teachers, coaches, and/or representatives are expected to ACTIVELY participate in judging all track & field events.

For example, Long Jump or Standing Jump Event Judge

- Responsible for the competition area and ensuring that it is prepared and ready for warm-ups and competition.
- Review assignments with all officials/volunteers for the event.
- Check in competitors early to allow time for warm-up attempts.
- Call the competitors during the competition with “up”, “on deck” and “on hold.”
- Hold one end of the measuring tape and read the result.
- Announce measured distances loud and clear.

Transportation: Transportation to & from the Meet will be the responsibility of parents/guardians.

Admission:

There will be no admission costs for spectators.

Awards:

Awards Area – Event medals will be presented for participants who finish 1st – 3rd place. 1st – 3rd place will be determined by the top three finishing times. Competitors will come to pick up their medals at the designated area. In our Tiny Tykes 50M Dash, all participants 5 and under will receive a ribbon for participating.

Concessions: Will be available

Results: Results will be emailed to the coaches.

Protests: Will be handled and decided by the Meet Directors

PROTESTS CONCERNING JUDGEMENT CALLS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Spectator Behavior:

Spectators and participants are expected to refrain from the use of profanity. Smoking is not allowed in the stadium. No one should be standing against the railing in the stands as it blocks the view of others. NO Canopies/Tents should be within the first 5 rows of the stands. Everyone should clean up behind themselves. Trash cans will be all around.
