Reminders

- ✓ When administering CPR on an adult you should do 30 compressions and 2 breaths
- ✓ When using an "ambu" bag you have to make sure you aren't pressing too hard or too fast to avoid bursting the patient's lung
- ✓ It's best to avoid using both hand when performing compression on a infant so you have to use your thumbs or either two finger

EVENTS

1st Station:

At the first station in the class the students learned how to administer CPR on an adult while also using a defibrillator.

2nd Station:

At the 2nd station students were taught how to properly use an "ambu" bag which is used to provide respiratory support to someone who can't breathe on their own

3rd Station:

Lastly the students learned how to administer CPR on an infant. This process was different because of the size difference and how fragile an infant is compared to an adult.
