

INCIDENT/ INJURY RESPONSE PLAN Richmond County School District

Follow all steps as outlined below for either an emergency or non-emergency injury.

Determine the type of injury: Emergency or Non-emergency. EMERGENCY

- 1. Call 911 for life-threatening situations, or severe injuries.
- 2. Report immediately to your <u>Kelly Representative</u>. You must talk to someone at Kelly. Do <u>not</u> leave a voicemail or send an email.

NON-EMERGENCY

1. Determine which applies: First Aid, Medcor Nurse Triage, **or** if medical care is requested and/or necessary. Then, follow the provided instructions for the appropriate scenario.

** If the employee declines care, proceed to Steps 2 and 3. **

First Aid	Onsite nurse if available
Medcor Nurse Triage: If no onsite first aid, or when a need for formal medical treatment is unclear	Medcor 24x7 Nurse Triage: providing immediate access to medical professionals who can make sound clinical decisions about when first aid is appropriate—and when a referral to an outside medical clinic is necessary Call 1-872-260-6757
Medical Care - Necessary or requested by the employee, send to the local Urgent Care Clinic. *Kelly employees should ideally drive themselves or ask their emergency contact for assistance. 1. <u>Call your Kelly Representative to report the injury, regardless if medical treatment is needed</u> or not.
