If your student is in high school, the school's graduation rate for English learners in 2023-2024 was 72%. Once your student meets the required English proficiency level on the WIDA ACCESS or Alternate ACCESS test, your student will no longer be classified as an English learner needing ESOL language program support.			
If your student has a disability, our special education and language support staff will explain how English language services are included in your student's Individualized Education Program (IEP). ESOL teachers collaborate with special education teacher to provide your student with the language support services documented in the IEP.
