RCSS receives L4GA from Georgia Department of Education

(AUGUSTA, GEORGIA) – The Richmond County School System has been awarded a \$700,000 grant from the Georgia Department of Education. The Literacy for Learning, Living, and Leading in Georgia (L4GA) grant supports efforts to improve literacy through schools, early learning providers and community leaders.
