RH K-8 School Improvement Plan Update

- **Literacy-** increase percentage of students reading on grade level by 20% by end of school year
 - Literacy Intervention Block, D.E.A.R. implementation on Fridays, Poetry Slam, Helen Ruffin Reading Bowl
- **Numeracy-** increase percentage of students performing on grade level by 15% by end of school year
 - Mathematics Intervention Block, Math Competition
- **Culture and Climate-** reduce: number of disciplinary referrals by 25%, number of student absences by 10%, and number of staff missing 5 or more days by 20% by end of school year
 - Difficulties due to pandemic and quarantining
 - Still striving for progress towards this goal

- Grades 3rd, 4th, 6th, 7th testing in Math and ELA
- Grade 5 testing in Math, ELA, and Science
- Grade 8 testing in all subjects

- Hains and Wheelless Road 5th graders to come to RHK8 for 6th grade (upon board approval)
- Possibility of additional teachers being added to staff

- Continue to monitor the implementation of PBIS to reinforce positive behavior.
- Incorporate instructional opportunities to inform the parent/guardians of instructional expectations.
- Continue to build lasting relationships with parent/guardians in an effort to bridge the gap between home and school.
